September 16, 2016 – Carl Gedeik, principal organist at The Miraculous Medal Shrine in Philadelphia, PA, invites the general public to the Shrine's opening concert featuring its new four-manual, custom Allen organ. Internationally known organist, master teacher, composer, and recording artist, Roger Nyquist, DMA, will perform Sunday, October 2, at 2pm showing the massive ensembles and colors of this instrument. Additionally, on Saturday, October 1, at 2pm Dr. Nyquist will conduct a workshop for organists offering practical tips to improve organ playing.

The all-organ program featuring works by Johann Sebastian Bach, Louis Vierne, Camille Saint-Saens, and Henri Mulet will be live-streamed at www.MiraculousMedal.org, and from the Miraculous Medal App, which is a free download. A CD of the two-hour concert will be available for future purchase at the CAMM Gift Shop at www.MiraculousMedal.org for \$25. Dr. Nyquist studied with organists Arthur Poister, Catharine Crozier, and André Marchal. His concert career is active throughout the United States and Europe. He has recorded extensively – with more than 24 albums (over 180 compositions) to his credit. He is listed in the *International Who's Who in Music*, *Outstanding Educators of America*, and *American Keyboard Artists*.
